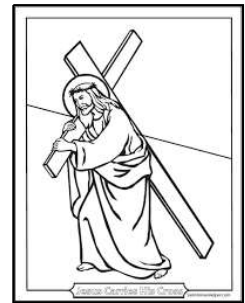

**Easter Flowers for the Altar**

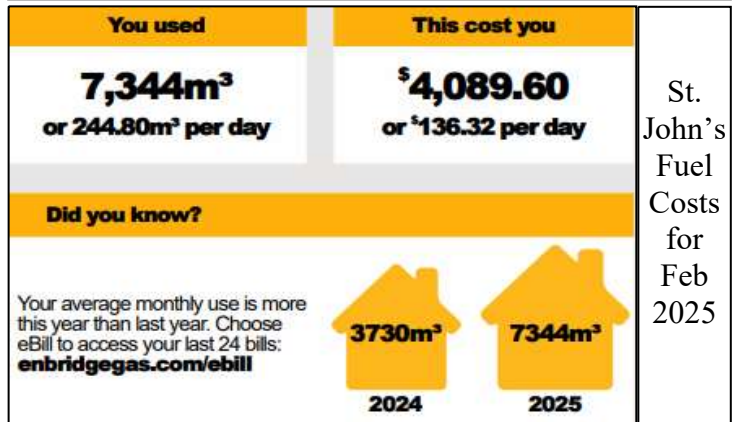
