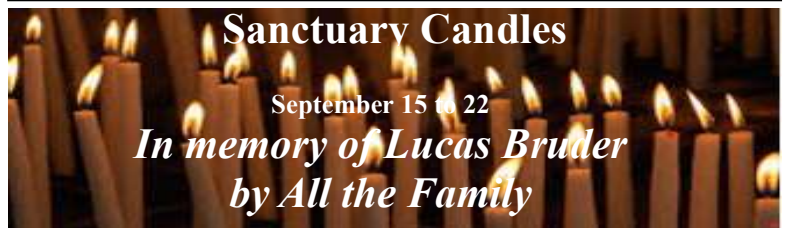

4:00 pm Depart from the Oratory in Montreal to return home.

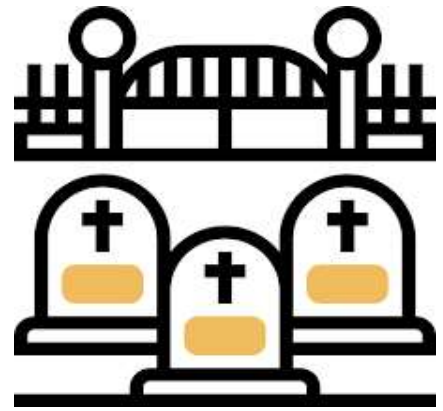
