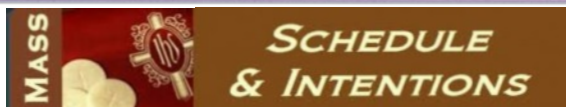

MESSAGE FROM FR. DALE:

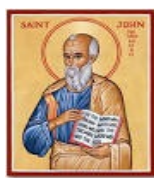
My Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

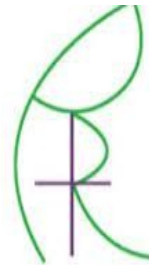
