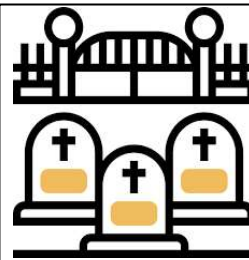
GANANOQUE FOOD BANK
